Everyone will wear warm-ups before and after performance if we have them. (black shirts, shorts, underneath uniforms. Band Camp T's after performance. Layer clothing.

You will eat supper after our field performance/critique – could be subject to change as we get closer to the weekend. Concessions are there if you don't get enough to eat.

Once our performance is over, we will get out of uniform, load trailer, etc. Everyone is expected to watch the rest of the contest. Attendance will be taken. Take everything with you off of the bus once we are loaded after our performance. The busses will be locked once we leave to watch the rest of the competition.

Upon returning to Rochelle, all instruments will be unloaded from the trailer as well as the front ensemble equipment including the pit trailer. The battery may stay loaded.

Reminders:

- **Respect each other, *other bands especially while watching their performances*(You are representing Rochelle, Rochelle Township High School and The Rochelle "Hub" Marching Band.**
- **Respect and be polite to bus drivers, chaperones, volunteer parents, trailer driver, etc.**
- **If you do not ride home on the bus you may not leave until after awards unless it is pre-arranged with Mr. Duval.**
- **We are on a schedule as indicated on the sheets provided. If you are not where you are supposed to be at the time you are supposed to be there, it could affect the outcome of the day.**

- Please arrange to have your parents pick you up shortly after we return.

REMEMBER: It is your responsibility to make sure that you are on the bus when you are supposed to, with your equipment, uniform, etc. You are responsible for loading/unloading your own equipment/ belongings.

SCHOOL POLICY: If you are not planning to ride the bus home you must fill out a parental permission slip (located on the marching band home page), and give it to either Mr. Duval or the chaperone of your bus on Sunday. You may not ride home with a friend, brother, sister or anyone under 21. If you plan on riding home with someone else's parent you need to fill out the entire form.
